Thank you for participating in Digital Dentistry Conference on Saturday 4th November 2023.

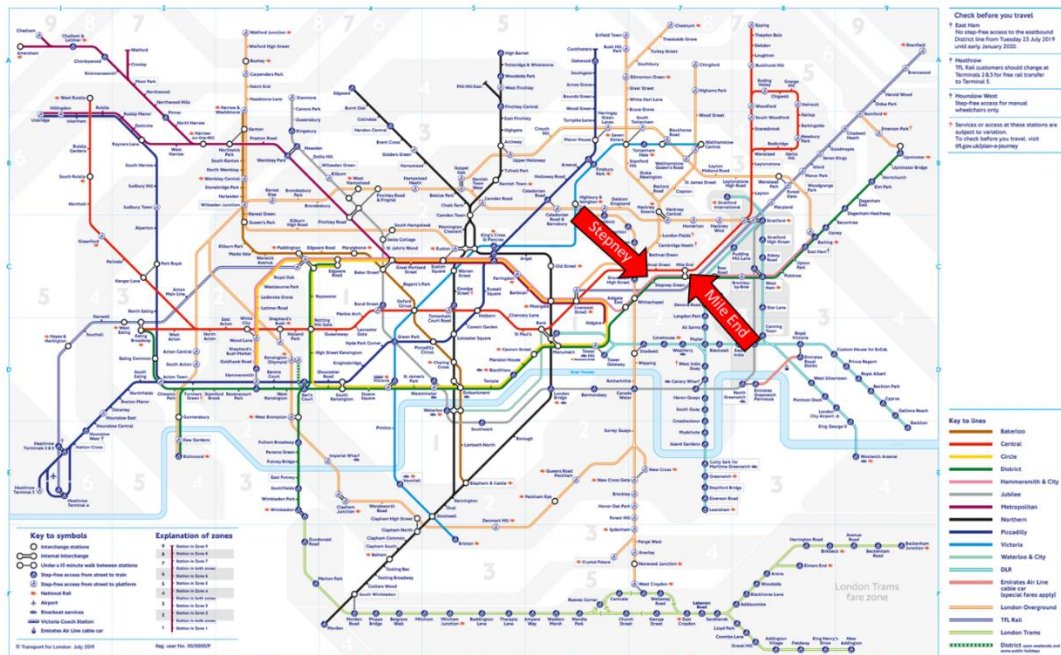

This conference is held at Arts Two Lecture Theatre, Queen Mary University (QMUL) at Mile End Rd, Bethnal Green, London, E1 4NS.

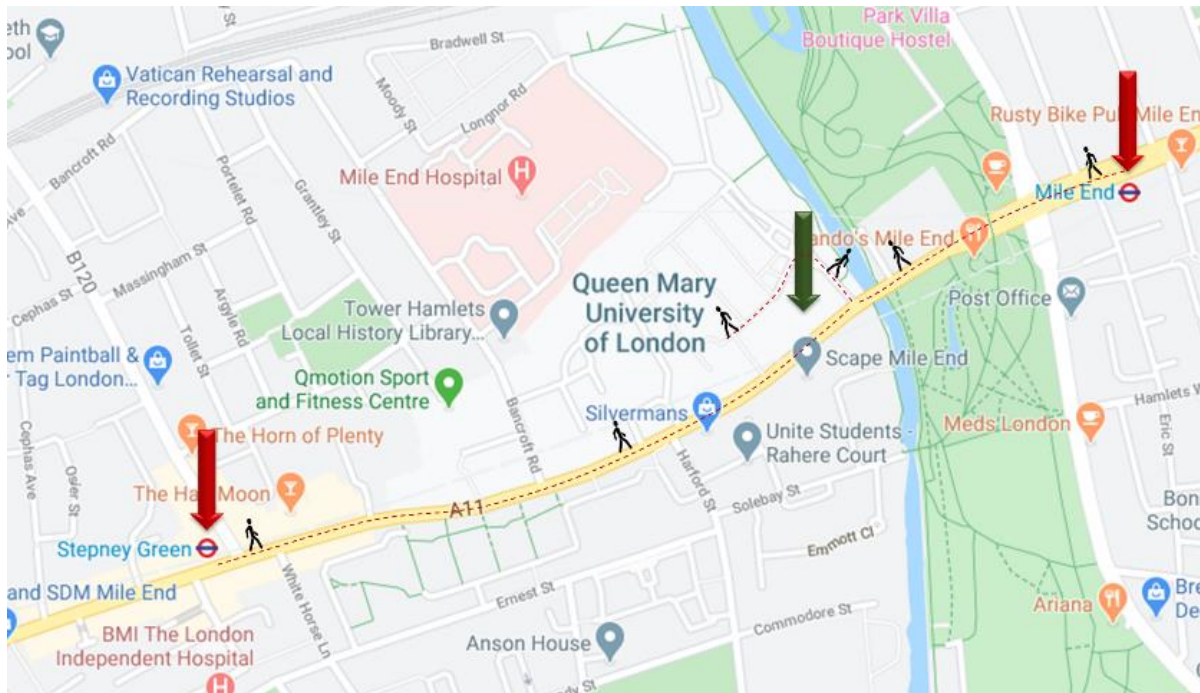
Train:

The Dental Institute is placed on Mile End Rd. Below is a map showing the route from both underground tubes to one of the QMUL the main entrances.

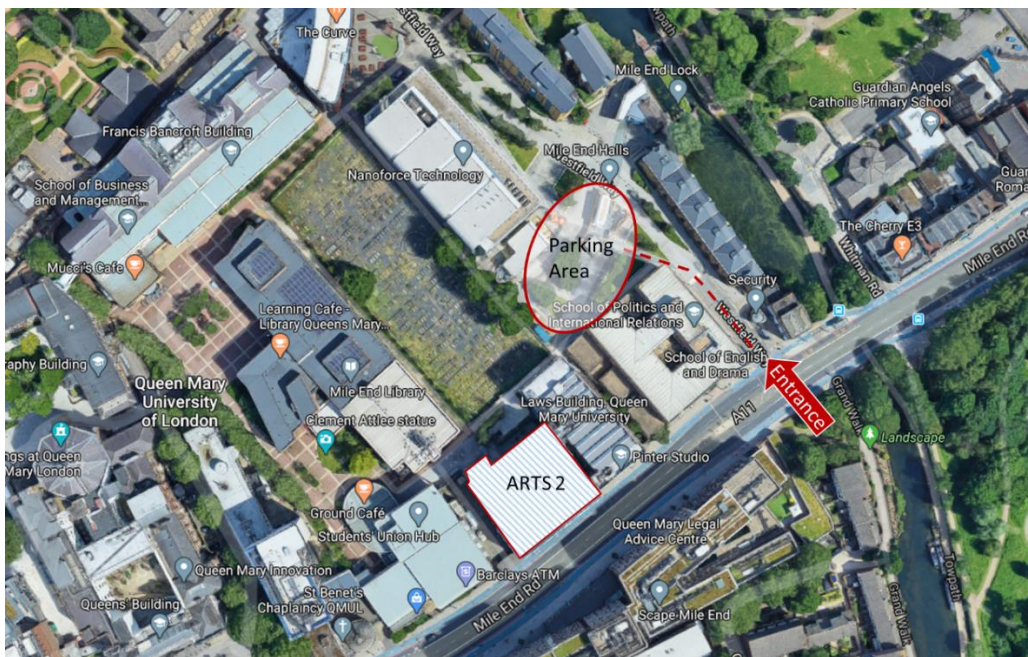


Car:
