About the Tour

The UK Dental Insight Tour is a unique 6-day programme designed for overseas dental and medical students, academics, and professionals who wish to gain first-hand exposure to British dental education, clinical practice, and academic innovation.

Set within one of the world's most respected healthcare and university systems, the tour combines academic engagement, cultural exploration, and professional networking. Participants will also attend the Advanced Dentistry & Innovation events organised by UKDC International [™] (Professional Health Hub Ltd – PHH) and hosted at one of the historic Buildings of London. Depending on the year, this event may be a conference, an exhibition, or a combined format.

The programme includes structured group activities as well as free time for independent exploration, all supported by experienced UK-based coordinators.

Provisional Itinerary

- **Day 1:** Arrival in London, hotel check-in, welcome briefing

- **Day 3:** Optional Oxford day trip*

- **Day 5:** Optional Cambridge day trip*
- **Day 6:** Free day for individual exploration
- **Day 7:** Departure

*Optional trips require a minimum number of participants. UKDC may modify or cancel optional activities if minimum numbers are not met.
